Lower Cook Inlet Subsistence Salmon Fishery Announcement

SOUTHERN DISTRICT: Beginning in 2022, subsistence salmon permits for the Port Graham and Nanwalek subsistence fisheries are available online through the ADF&G permit website. General instructions to apply for a subsistence permit are outlined below,

- 1.) Go to www.adfg.alaska.gov/Store/
- 2.) Select either “Shop as Guest”, or “Sign in and Shop”.
- 3.) If “Shop as Guest” is selected enter your name, date of birth, and other information as requested. Press “Start Shopping”.

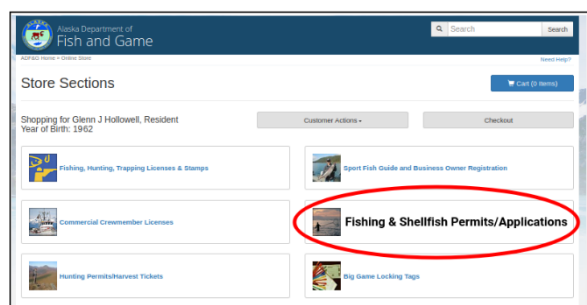
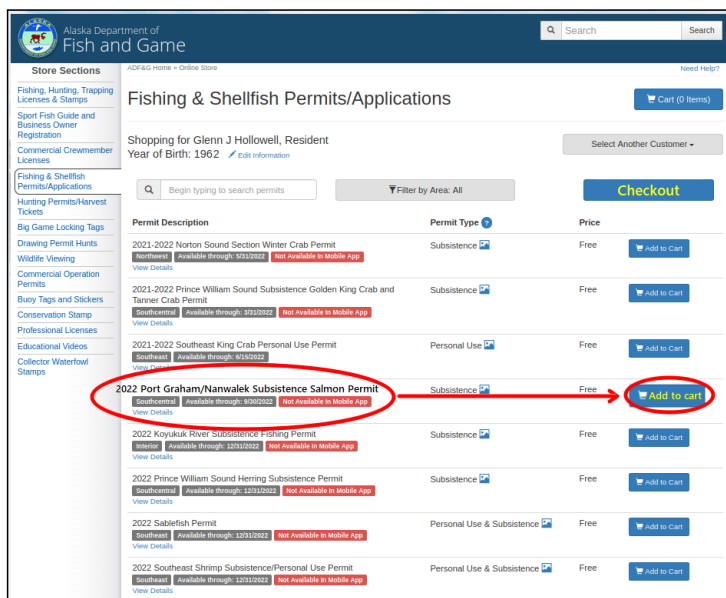


Figure 1.- Showing store section for subsistence permits.

- 4.) Select “Fishing & Shellfish Permits/Applications” (Figure 1).

- 5.) Next screen, find “Port Graham/Nanwalek Subsistence Salmon Permit” and select “add to cart” (Figure 2).

- 6.) If there are no other permits that need to be applied for, select “Checkout” near the top of the page shown in Figure 2. The next screen will show the permits that are being applied for. The 2022 Port Graham/Nanwalek Subsistence Salmon Permit should be on this page. Select “Proceed to Checkout”.

7.) This is where the subsistence user’s information is entered. Select Save/Continue when all information is entered (Figure 3).

8.)The screen at left, (Figure 4, “Purchasing Agreement”) asks the applicant to confirm that entered information is accurate and correct. Subsistence permits are free and do not cost money. Check the “I agree” box if appropriate and select “Purchase Now”.

9.) The next screen is where the actual permit can be printed. Select the “Print Documents” button (Figure 5).
