Lower Cook Inlet Salmon Fishery News Release #4

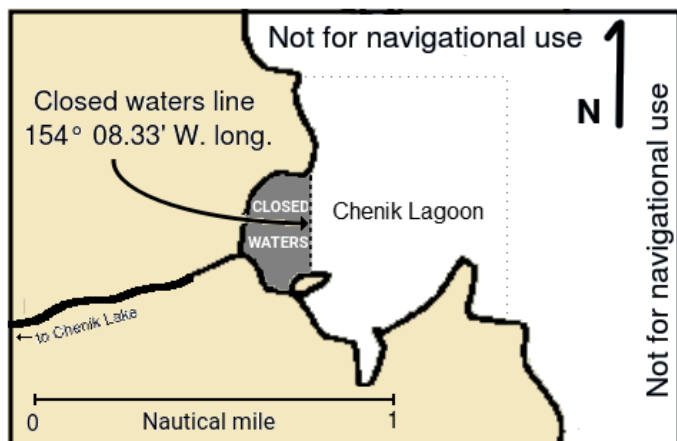


Figure 1.- Chenik Lagoon, west of 154° 08.33' W. longitude is closed.

KAMISHAK DISTRICT: Effective June 15, at 12:01 AM, waters of the Kirschner Lake special harvest area are closed to commercial common property salmon harvest until further notice. Other subdistricts of the Kamishak District as defined in 5AAC 21.299(e), excluding the McNeil River Subdistrict and the Paint River Subdistrict remain open. Fishing periods are 7-days per week, 24-hours per day. Effective Monday, June 13 waters of Chenik Lagoon east of 154° 08.33' W. long. (Figure 1) opened to commercial salmon harvest. General closed waters restrictions (5AAC 39.290) and 21.350(h) and (i) are rescinded in Chenik Lagoon until further notice.

The next scheduled commercial salmon fisheries announcement is anticipated to be on Friday, June 17.
