PORT MOLLER COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #14 **For Emergency Orders #4-FS-M-PM-14-22**

The Nelson Lagoon Section will close to commercial salmon fishing at 11:59 p.m. Wednesday, July 13. That portion of the Bear River Section located from a 280° bearing perpendicular to the beach at the Bear River Church located at 160° 26.00' W. long. to the Sandy River Bluffs at 160° 19.64' W. long will remain closed to commercial salmon fishing until further notice. The closed waters at Bear River will remain reduced to the stream terminus at the ocean shoreline until further notice, as per previous Advisory Announcement. The remaining portion of the Bear River, Three Hills, and the Ilnik Sections will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 13 until 6:00 p.m. Friday, July 15. The Port Moller Bight Section will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Thursday, July 14 until 6:00 p.m. Thursday, July 21.
