Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Announcement #32 **Emergency Orders 74, 75, & 76**

This is the Alaska Department of Fish & Game in King Salmon with an announcement for permit holders in the Naknek-Kvichak, Egegik, and Ugashik districts. The time is 12:00 noon and the date is Friday, July 15, 2022.

Naknek-Kvichak District

On July 14, Naknek River escapement was 83,000 fish for a cumulative of 1.7 million; Alagnak River escapement was 104,000 for a cumulative of 1.2 million; and Kvichak River escapement was 383,000 for a cumulative of 3.4 million. The Naknek-Kvichak District harvest on July 14 was 1.1 million fish for a total catch of 12.0 million. There are 520 vessels registered to fish in the district.

The Naknek-Kvichak District will open to drift gillnet gear for a 19.5-hour period from 2:00 a.m. until 9:30 p.m. Saturday, July 16. Commercial fishing with set gillnets in the Naknek-Kvichak District is extended until further notice.

Egegik District

Egegik Tower passed 37,000 fish on July 14, bringing the season total to 1.6 million. Egegik District harvest from July 14 was 423,000, for a season total of 14.3 million fish.

Egegik District will open to commercial fishing with set gillnet gear for 20 hours from 1:15 a.m. until 9:15 p.m. Saturday, July 16. Commercial fishing with drift gillnet gear will open for 8 hours from 1:15 a.m. until 9:15 a.m. Saturday, July 16 and again for 8 hours from 1:15 p.m. until 9:15 p.m. Saturday, July 16.

Ugashik District

The Ugashik River tower passed 66,000 on July 14, bringing the season total to 1.2 million fish. Harvest from July 14 was 380,000 fish, for a season total of 5.2 million. There are currently 245 vessels registered in the district.

Ugashik District will open to commercial fishing with both set and drift gillnet gear for 16 hours from 11:30 a.m. Saturday, July 16 until 3:30 a.m. Sunday, July 17.
