### **Antlerless Moose Permit to be issued online**

#### **RM768, Northwestern 20A, Only 20 Online Permits Available**

(Fairbanks) – Game Management Unit 20A antlerless moose permit, RM768, will be available online **to the first 20 qualified hunters that register beginning August 26 at 9:00 am**. The RM768 permit is a limited registration permit normally given out each year in Nenana at the end of August. The permits are available on a first-come first-served basis. This year, due to potential safety concerns regarding Covid-19 the permits will be available online at [www.hunt.alaska.gov](http://www.hunt.alaska.gov) until 20 permits are issued. Permits will not be available in person in Nenana.

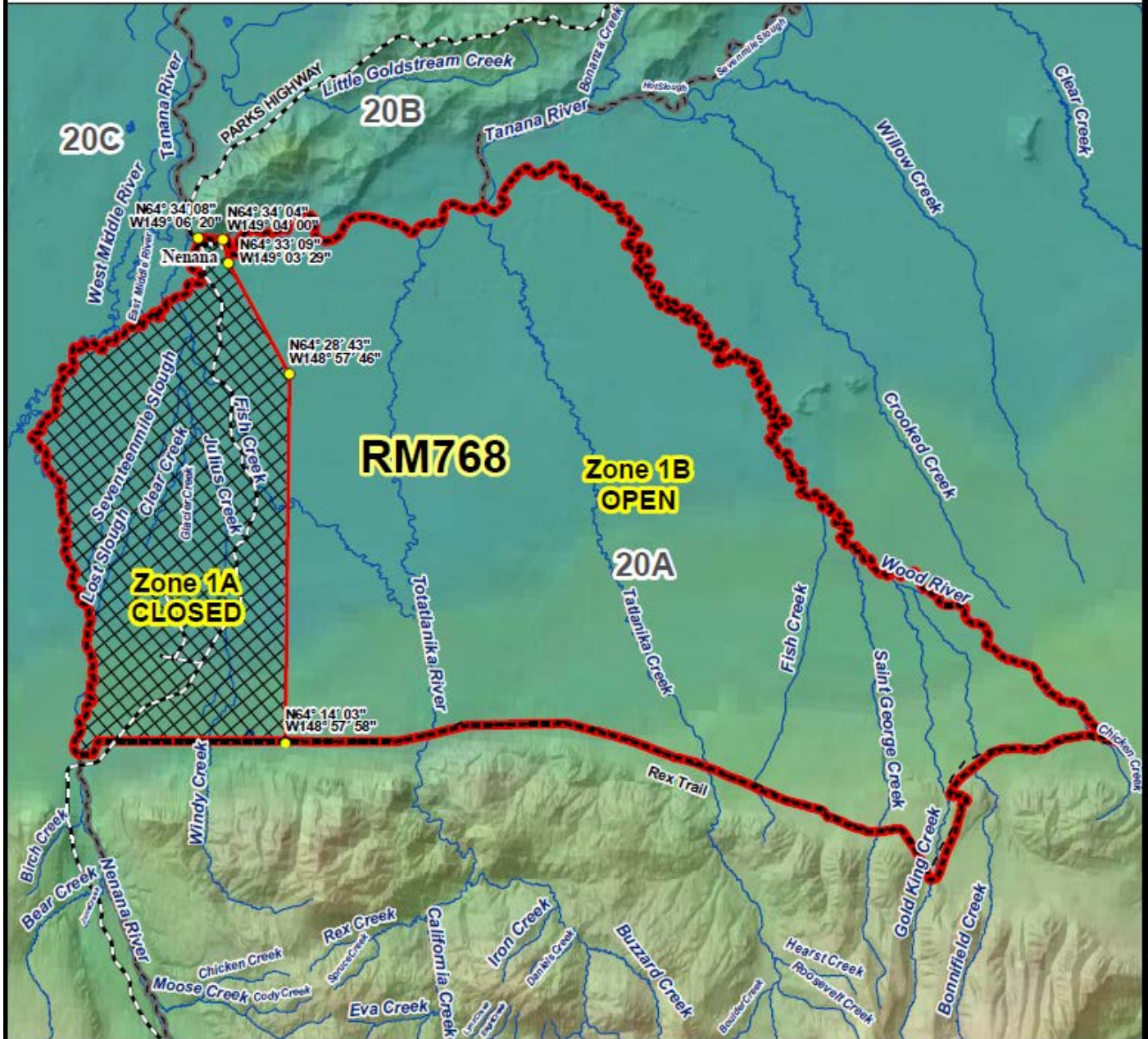
Fairbanks Area Biologist Tony Hollis said, “People are being asked to maintain social distancing, and this is one way we can help them do that. So instead of issuing permits in Nenana that would bring an influx of people into the community we are issuing them online”.

The permit is open to any qualified Alaskan resident, but only 1 permit per household is allowed. The season is October 1 – February 28.

The Board of Game authorized the Department to issue a limited registration permit for antlerless moose in the Northwest portion of Unit 20A. The number of permits issued each year is adjusted based on moose population estimates in the area.

Hunters should be aware of local ordinances and restrictions aimed at preventing the spread of COVID. Please respect any local restrictions, wear face coverings and practice social distancing when in communities near the hunt area. Hunters are also advised to call ahead to find out if local communities have supplies available for sale.
