

# 2020 Haines Management Area Subsistence and Personal Use Salmon Fishing Permit Conditions

## SUBSISTENCE SALMON FISHING GENERAL PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. In the Haines Management Area, the freshwater subsistence fishing area is the Chilkat River from mile 4 of the Haines Highway to a point 1 mile upstream of the Wells Bridge. The saltwater subsistence fishing area is Chilkat Inlet north of the latitude of Glacier Point, Lutak Inlet, and Chilkoot Inlet north of the latitude of Battery Point, excluding waters of Taiya Inlet north of the latitude of Taiya Point. 5 AAC 01.716 (13)(A)(ii). See map on reverse for boundaries.
2. **Due to Chilkat River Chinook salmon stock concerns, NO LIVE CHINOOK SALMON MAY BE RETAINED.**
3. (NEW) A separate form is required for proxy fishing. Please contact the Haines ADF&G

## CHILKAT RIVER PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. Legal gear is set or drift gillnet. Maximum net length is 50 feet.
2. The permit holder must attend the net at all times 5 AAC 01.730 (c).
3. *Open:* June 1–June 14, from 4-mile Haines Hwy to 1 mile upstream of the Wells Bridge.
4. *Open:* June 15–July 31, **only from 19-mile Haines Highway to the Wells Bridge, and only Wednesday through Saturday (4 days per week).**
5. *Open:* August 1–September 30, from 4-mile Haines Hwy to 1 mile upstream of the Wells Bridge.
6. *For Chilkat River harvest recording, the immediate fishing area is within 100 feet of the harvest area.*

## SALTWATER PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. Legal gear is drift gillnet only. Maximum net length is 300 feet (50 fathoms).
2. The saltwater subsistence fishing season starts June 20 and ends September 30, or when the commercial fishing season ends.
3. *Open:* Salt water subsistence salmon fishing is closed during closed periods of the District 15 commercial salmon net fishery, except that subsistence salmon may be taken on the Saturday before, starting at 12:01 am, and the day before any period that the commercial salmon net fishery is open in the waters of Section 15-A. 5 AAC 01.725 (2). For weekly opening dates, the permittee must monitor posted Advisory Announcements online at [www.adfg.alaska.gov/index.cfm?adfg=cfnews.main](http://www.adfg.alaska.gov/index.cfm?adfg=cfnews.main). Select the “Southeast/Yakutat” Management Area, “Gillnet” Gear Class, then click the “Search” button. The most current Advisory Announcement will be shown at the top.
4. *Open:* **Starting June 20, only Lutak and Chilkoot Inlets, north of Battery Point.**
5. *Closed:* **Through July 17, Chilkat Inlet will remain closed.**
6. *Open:* **Starting July 18, Chilkat Inlet north of Glacier Point and south of Letnikof Point light.**
7. *Open:* **Starting July 25, Chilkat Inlet north of Glacier Point.**

## PERSONAL USE SALMON FISHING PERMIT CONDITIONS REGULATION

1. Salmon may be taken for personal use under this permit in Taiya River with a possession limit of 10 pink and chum salmon, combined, with an annual limit of 20 pink and chum salmon, combined per household. 5 AAC 77.682 (o).
2. In District 15, Lynn Canal salmon may not be taken during closed periods of the commercial salmon net fishery in District 15. 5 AAC 77.682(2).
