And with major multiple Carnivore Regime shifting in favor of: Dogfish-shark, skates, Lingcod, and Sand Fleas; ~~durability~~

Future closing of zero to one mile (minimum) of Any Trawl, Scallop and Fish, to Allow a possible recovery of Dungeness Crab stocks.

The other is "Area A" Pot shrimp Fishery season.

Lower quota (to allow for Non Roe Weight), and to move to ^a Spring
