Proposal 56

Regarding RC 124, the Village of Levelock agrees to ADF&G's cost estimate to monitor sockeye and king salmon escapements to the Alagnak River, along with other provisions regarding tower operations contained in RC 124. Cost of monitoring salmon estimates in RC 124 are as follows: \$127,000 for first-year start up; and \$87,000 per season for ongoing subsequent years' monitoring. However, we agree to an operational period of a minimum of three years, and not five years as RC 124 states. Additionally, we would like this cooperative agreement to begin in 2017.
