

Record Comment- Proposal 60

We ask the Board of Fisheries to move the "temporary terminus" marker signs placed at the mouth of Graveyard Creek by enforcement in 2011 back a distance far enough to remedy the problem and accommodate the historical sites being restored, as seen in RC 137. This is an area which until 2011 was recognized as legal fishing sites for four decades.

Justification:

- My brother and I have fished these sites our entire lives. If this is not remedied, we lose not only opportunity but also our equitable interest. We believe the Board should take into account our rights via "grandfather rights" when considering this proposal.
- We have actively and aggressively defended and fished these sites as a family for over 50 years. Three generations of our family has fished there.
- A long standing ADL inside of Graveyard Creek is hard evidence to support all testimony that fishing the sites in consideration was legal and proper at the times they were being utilized.

Compromise:

In an effort to come to a solution, having taken certain variables into consideration, we offer the above compromise. This compromise causes us to lose two other sites which we had there.
