5 AAC 01.220. Lawful gear and gear specifications

(k) A person may use a hook and line attached to a rod or pole when subsistence fishing only

(1) in the waters between the latitude of Point Romanof and the latitude of the westernmost point of the Naskonat Peninsula, including those waters draining into the Bering Sea and those of the Yukon River drainage downstream from the [LOWER MOUTH OF PAIMIUT SLOUGH] the mouth of the Nulato River, including the Nulato River drainage ; or

(2) through the ice.
