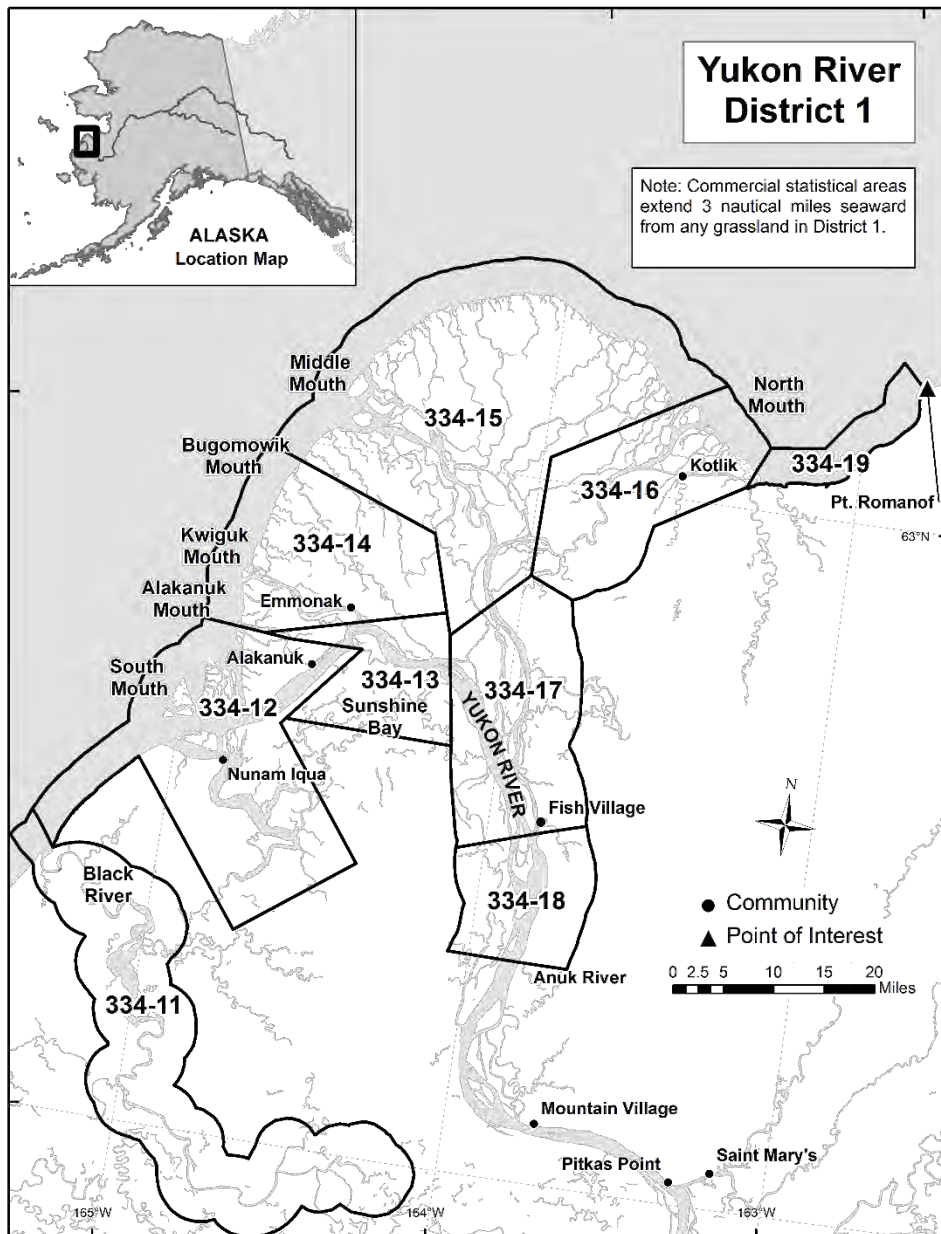


Figure RC 51-1. District 1 statistical areas, Yukon Area.
