

Draft regulation language - Family Set Net Second Permit Own and Operate

The purpose of the following proposed language is to provide for family set net operations to maintain the family operation as family permit holders leave the fishery. In summary this language provides limited authorization for a Bristol Bay set net permit holder to own and operate a second Bristol Bay set net permit, if the second permit was transferred from a family member who has owned and operated that permit for a proscribed period of time.

Note: Regulation draft is related to the Commercial Fishing Entry Commission section. Additional language may be required for Commercial Fisheries regulations .

20 AAC 05.1946. Issuance of permit cards for salmon fisheries under as 16.43.140(c)(5).

(3) **except as provided in (D)**, may not,

(A) engage in fishing in fishing with the second entry permit unless additional fishing ...

(D) a set net permit holder with a second set net entry permit, may own and operate such second set net permit, if meeting the requirements as follows:

(a) the second entry permit was transferred from a family member, defined as (c) below, who has owned and operated transferred permit for at least xx (5-10?) years, and the permit holder with the second permit has owned and operated the first permit for at least xx (5-10?) years,

(b) for a period of xx (5?) years, the second permit may only be operated on fishing sites the permit holder or transferor family member own and operate at the time of transfer of the second permit,

(c) a family for the purposes of this section is defined as a grandfather, grandmother, father, mother, brother, sister, son, daughter.
