Regarding Proposal #34

Members of the Board,

It has come to my attention that when I drafted proposal #34 and calculated a point on the map north of the current boundary I was using the pre-2016 boundary point in my calculations. As a result my proposed lat/long coordinate isn't consistent with the purpose of the proposal nor the written explanation.

To aid the board in adopting my proposal I would like to provide 58°52'4.68"N LAT 157° 0'48.00"W as a point 50' due north of the current marker. The revised proposal would modify the regulations to read:

5 AAC 06.350(b)(1) is amended to read:

(b) The following locations in the Naknek-Kvichak District are closed to the taking of salmon: (1) those waters northeast of a line from a point near Graveyard Point at [58°52'4.68"N LAT 157° 0'48.00"W. LONG] to a point on the northwest shore of Kvichak Bay at 58° 53.37' N lat., 157° 04.26' W. long.;

I am sorry for the confusion this mathematical error will have certainly caused for the other stake holders and for the Board.
