

NOTICE OF A MEETING OF THE ALASKA BOARD OF FISHERIES

The Alaska Board of Fisheries (board) will hold a special emergency petition meeting immediately on August 2, 2021 starting at 10:00 a.m. The meeting will be held through web conference.

The purpose of the special meeting is to address the board's delegation to the department under *2015-277-FB, Standing Delegation of Authority to the Commissioner Regarding Petitions for Emergency Regulations*, and emergency petitions from Chris Every received July 23, 2021, and South-K Beach Independent Fishermen's Association, received July 24, 2021, both regarding the commercial salmon fishery in Upper Cook Inlet. At the meeting the board will consider whether an emergency exists under 5 AAC 96.625 and may consider whether to adopt emergency regulations under 5 AAC 21.

The board is not taking written comment or oral public testimony during the meeting. A live audio stream of the meeting is intended to be available on the Board's website, which can be accessed at www.boardoffisheries.adfg.alaska.gov.

If the Board takes emergency action to amend the registration requirements, any amendment will expire 120 days after it becomes effective, pursuant to AS 44.62.260, unless the Board takes additional regulatory action to make the amendment permanent. The Board will provide additional notice of, and opportunity to comment on, any further regulatory action on this topic, including any action to make an amendment permanent. The Board may also delegate to the Commissioner authority to take regulatory action on this topic.

The board may go into executive session to discuss legal matters and may handle other administrative matters under miscellaneous business.
